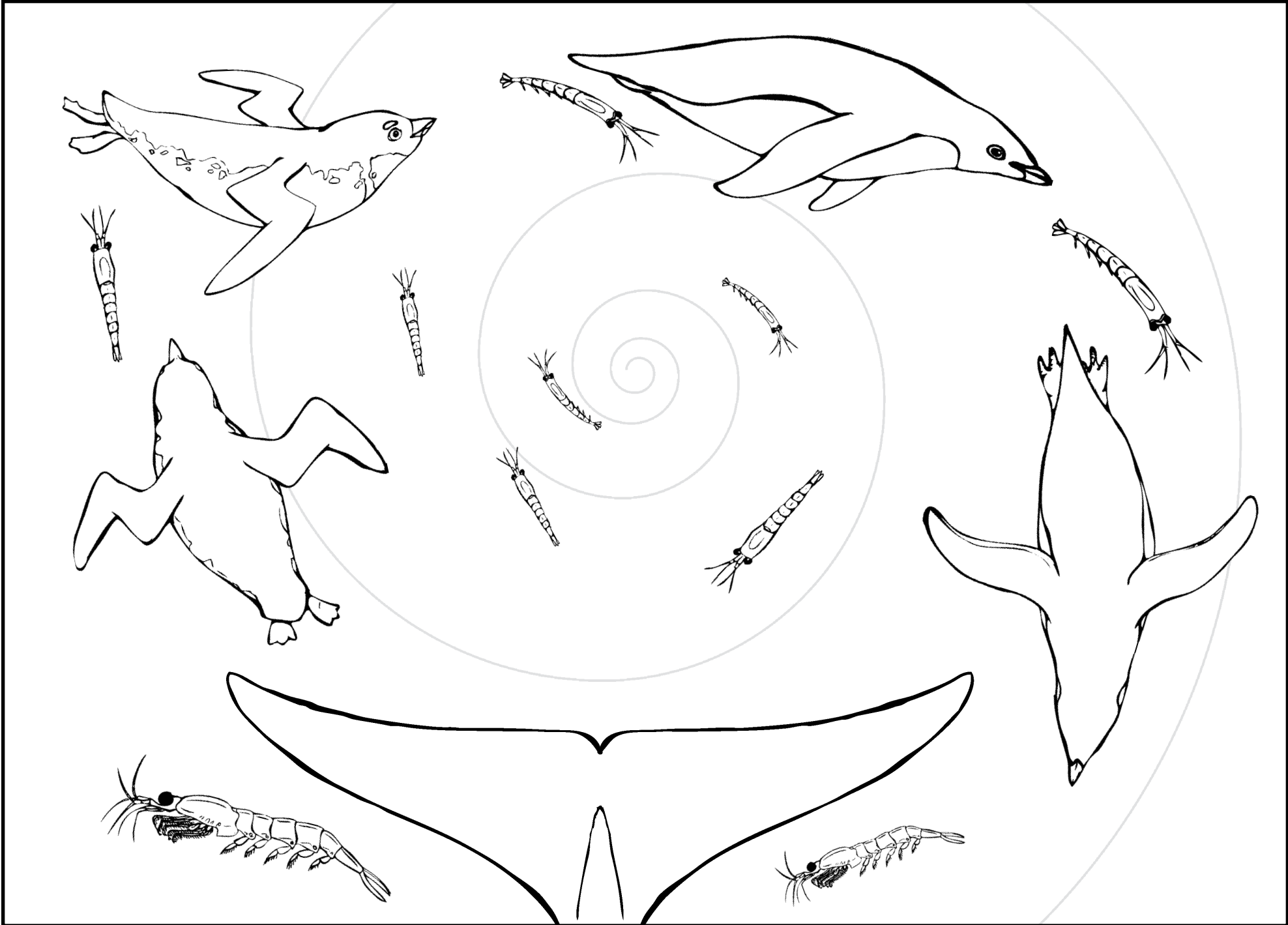
Where in the World?

Color the marine animals and identify which oceans they live in.



Krill Connections

Color the krill and the marine animals that depend on them for food.



Draw a Cassin's Auklet

Markers, pencils, or crayons: black, gray, light blue

1. Draw the body.



2. Add the feet, front edge of wings, and the bill.



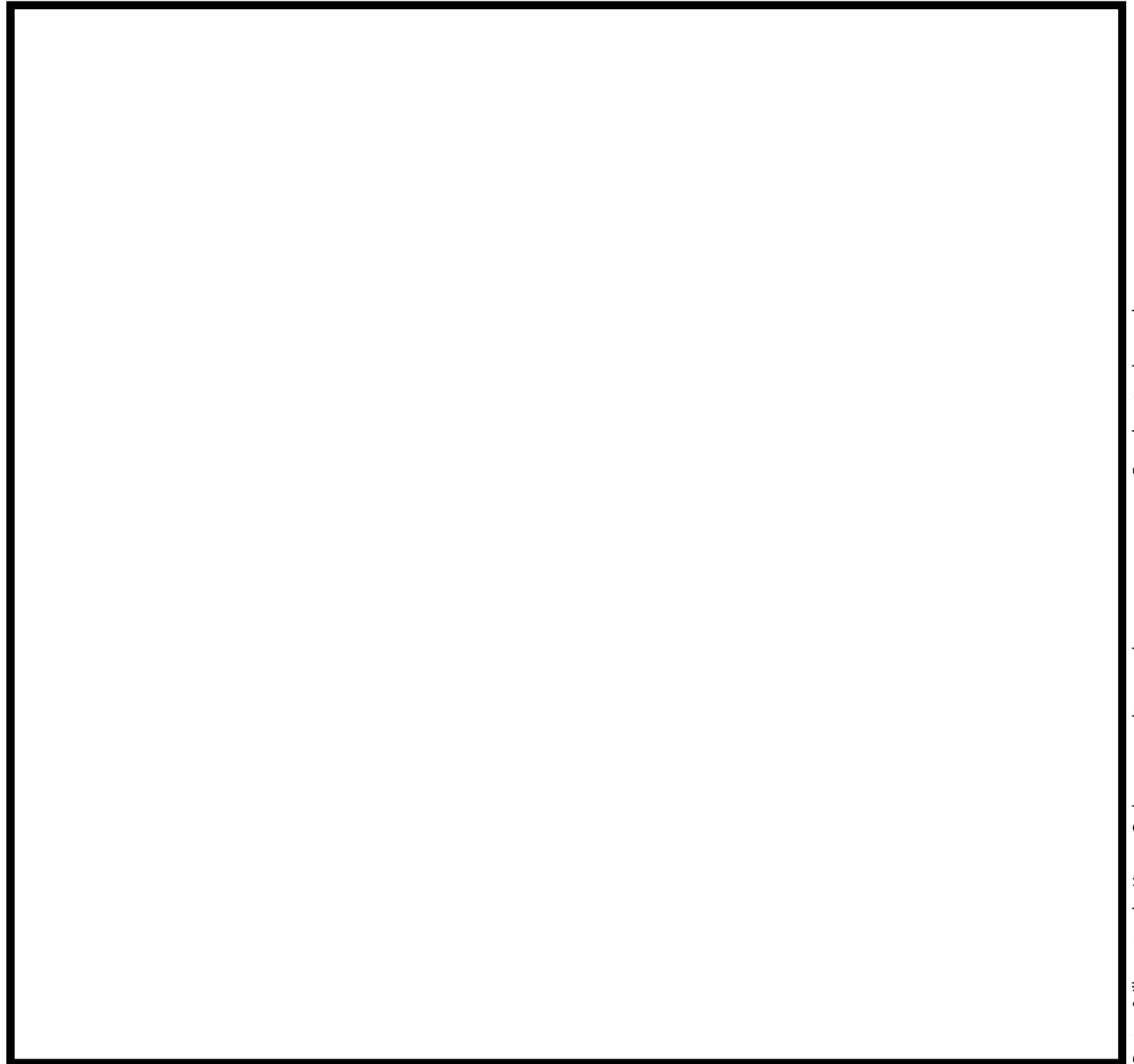
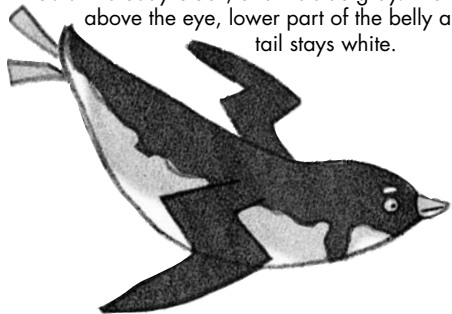
3. Finish the wings, add eyeball and 'eyebrow'



4. Add the mouth, eye, and a line showing where the gray-white belly and black back feathers meet.



5. Color the seabird's bill, feet and eye light blue.
Color it's body black, and it's side gray. The spot above the eye, lower part of the belly and tail stays white.

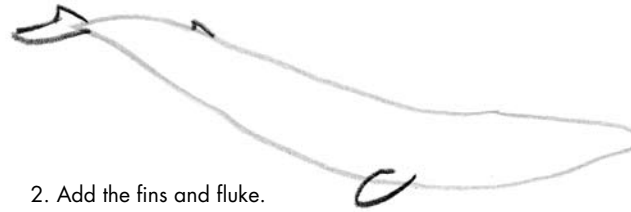


Draw a Blue Whale

Markers, pencils, or crayons: gray, light blue



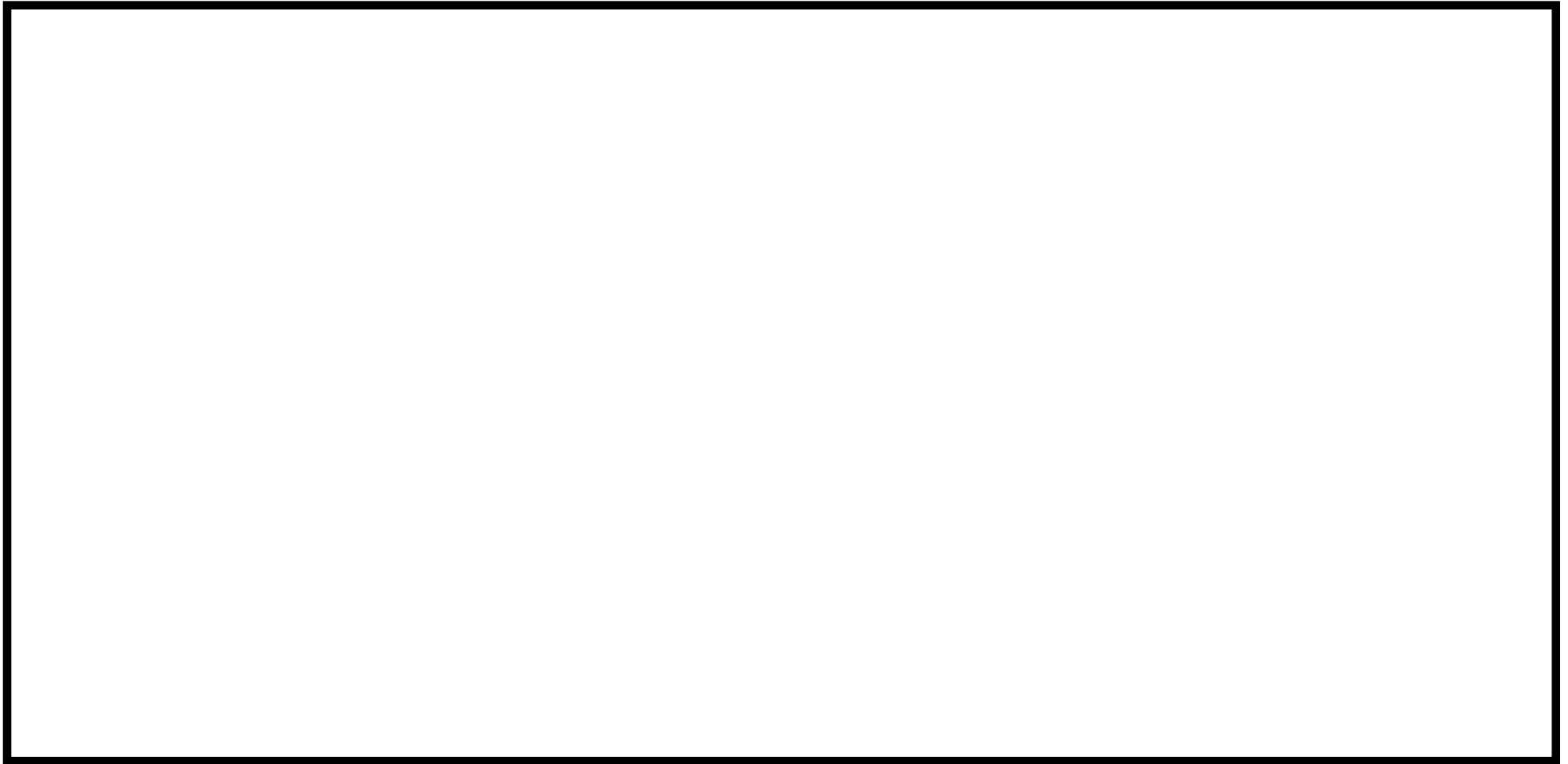
1. Draw the body.



2. Add the fins and fluke.



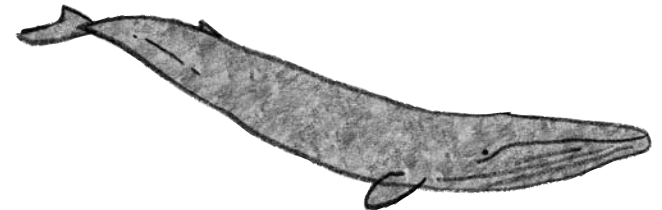
3. Add the mouth and eye.



4. Add the throat grooves and tail detail.



5. Color the whale gray, use a little light blue to add patches of color on the body.



Draw an Adélie Penguin

Markers, pencils, or crayons: black, orange

1. Draw the body.



2. Add foot, one wing tip, eyeball and bill.



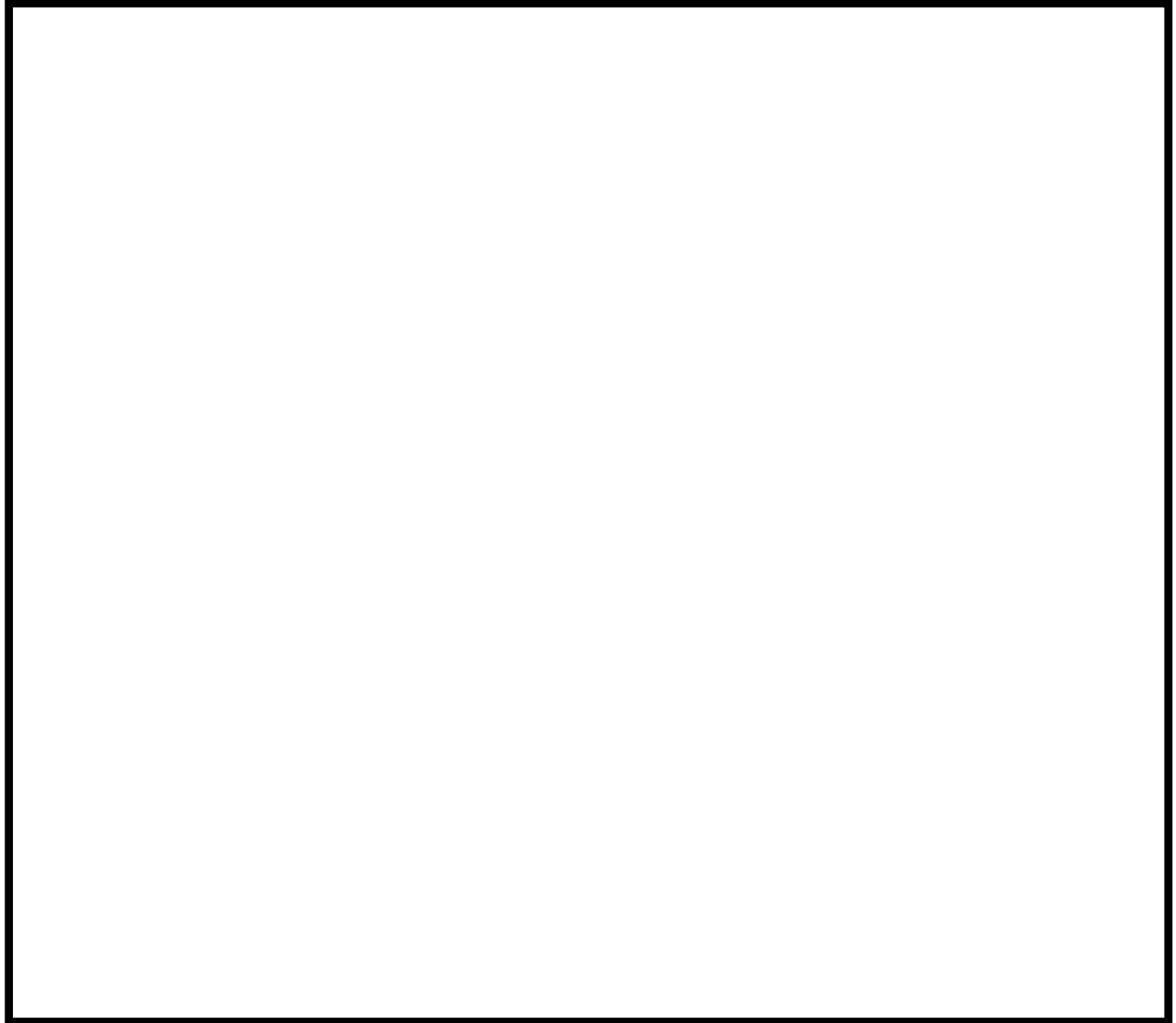
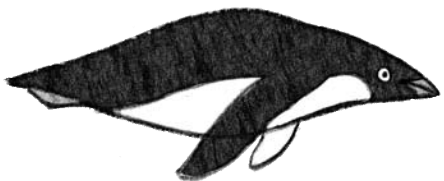
3. Add a line that shows where the black and white feathers meet.



4. Add eye and mouth.



5. Color the penguin's bill and feet orange and it's body black. Leave the belly and one wing white.



Draw a Krill

Markers, pencils, or crayons: light blue, red, orange and pink

1. Draw the body.



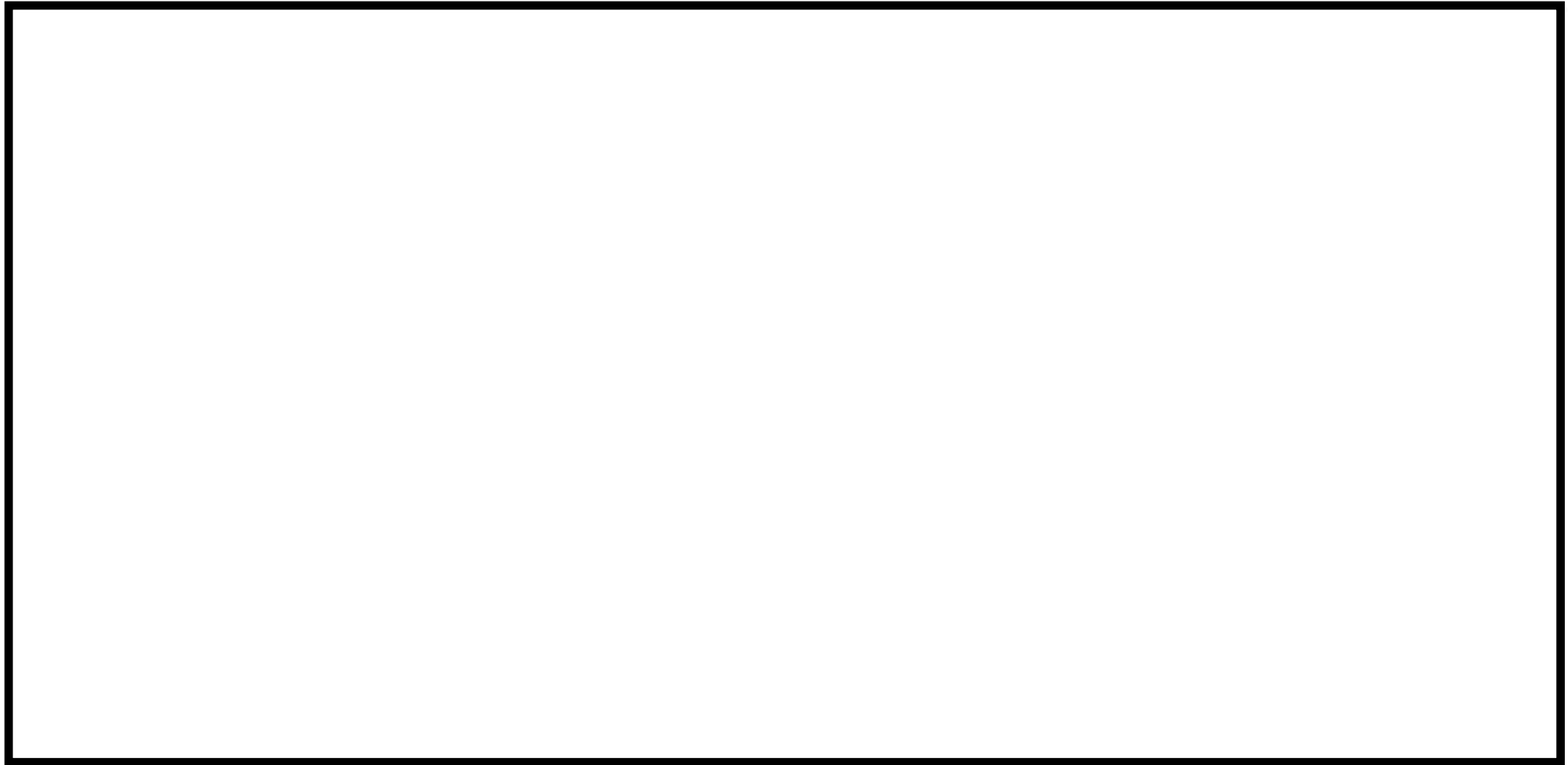
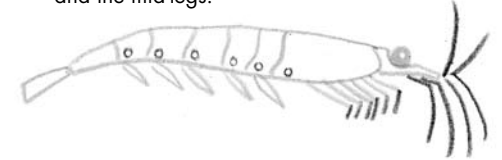
2. Add the tail, swimming legs, and head.



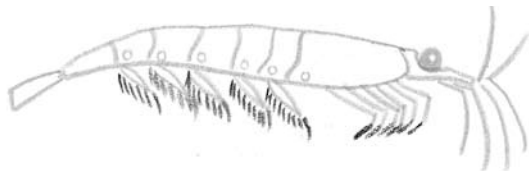
3. Add the segments, and six upper-legs.



4. Add the photophores (circles), antenna, and the mid-legs.



5. Add the lower-legs and bristle-like hairs.



5. Use light blue to color the interior, red for the photophores, add orange and pink speckles along the top of the body.
